Clifford Geertz (1926-)

(1926) Nascido em 23 de agosto em São Francisco, EUA

(1943-1945) Serve na Marinha americana durante a 2^a. Guerra Mundial

(1950) Graduiu-se em Filosofia (Major) no Antioch College; sua primeira escolha de Major fora Literatura Inglesa; queria ser jornalista (fez estágio no New York Post como copyboy) e escritor de obras de ficção

(1956) Ph.D. em Harvard (Antropologia)

(1958-1960) Assistant Professor of Anthropology, University of California, Berkeley

(1960-1970) Professor of Anthropology, University of Chicago

(1970-2000) Professor of Social Science, Institute for Advanced Study (primeiro e único antropólogo a entrar neste Instituto), Princeton, NJ

(1975-2000) Visiting Lecturer with Rank of Professor, Department of History, Princeton University

(1978-1979) Eastman Professor, Oxford University

(2000) Professor emeritus, Institute for Advanced Study, Princeton, NJ
